**IN PERSON MASS RETURNS NEXT SUNDAY!**

Our parish family will gather **next Sunday**, August 1<sup>st</sup> to celebrate our return to in-person Sunday Mass at 9:00 a.m. Our plan includes a procession into the church (a prayer ritual/blessing) beginning outside or in the church vestibule depending on the weather. We will gather on the plaza as we do on Palm Sunday celebration (processing around the parking lot, in front of the rectory and back into the vestibule). After Mass there will be a celebratory meal in the school gymnasium. If you received a missalette at the Easter services, please remember to bring it with you next week. **Reminder: masks must be worn.**

**PRAY FOR THE UNBORN:** The Rosary is said every 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday before Mass. Please join us in the Sanctuary.  
**SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:** Preparation and celebration of sacrament scheduled as needed. **Call the parish office.**  
**RECONCILIATION** is celebrated before Mass, and by appointment.  
**SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:** The Archdiocese requires a four-month preparation period before marriage. A couple **must** inform the Parish Office before a date is set.  
**SACRAMENT OF FIRST EUCHARIST:** In order to receive the sacrament of First Eucharist in Second Grade, children must regularly participate in Catholic religious education in Kindergarten and First Grade.  
**CONFIRMATION:** In order to receive the sacrament of Confirmation, young people must have regularly participated in Catholic religious education from First Eucharist until they are a Junior in High School. Classes are held the last Sunday of each month.  
**RCIA:** Adult religious education classes – every Wednesday at 7 p.m. from September through Pentecost.  
**SUNDAY SCHOOL/CCD:** Children/youth religious education classes every Sunday after Mass, September through May.
