## WELCOME

The Resurrection family is pleased to welcome today three distinguished scholars in the African-American Catholic community: **Father Dr. Bryan Massingale** and **Dr. Craig Ford**, two of the leading scholars of Christian ethics and morality in the United States, and **Father John Odeyemi**. Father Bryan is the James and Nancy Buckman Chair in Applied Christian Ethics in the Department of Theology at Fordham University in New York City. Dr. Ford is on the faculty of Saint Norbert College in De Pere, Wisconsin as Assistant Professor of Theology. He is the 2022 recipient of the Catherine Mowry LaCunga Award from the Catholic Theological Society of America, the first Black winner in the award’s 17-year history. Father John serves on the faculty of Xavier University of Louisiana in the Department of Theology. All three of these men have been of service to the American Catholic Church in numerous universities, parishes and Catholic entities. We are blessed to have them with us today. **Welcome!**

## THE ASSUMPTION

The Assumption is the oldest feast day of Our Lady. All the feast days of Mary mark the great mysteries of her life and her part in the work of redemption. The central mystery of her life and person is her divine motherhood, celebrated both at Christmas and a week later (Jan. 1) on the feast of the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. The Immaculate Conception (Dec. 8) marks the preparation for that motherhood, so that she had the fullness of grace from the first moment of her existence, completely untouched by sin. Her whole being throbbled with divine life from the very beginning, readying her for the exalted role of mother of the Savior.

The Assumption completes God's work in her since it was not fitting that the flesh that had given life to God himself should ever undergo corruption. The Assumption is God's crowning of His work as Mary ends her earthly life and enters eternity. The feast turns our eyes in that direction, where we will follow when our earthly life is over.

**SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:** Call the parish office to schedule a baptism class as well as a date for the baptism.

**RECONCILIATION** is celebrated before Mass, and by appointment.

**SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:** The Archdiocese requires a four-month preparation period before marriage. A couple **must** inform the Parish Office before a date is set.

**SACRAMENT OF FIRST EUCHARIST:** In order to receive the sacrament of First Eucharist in Second Grade, children must regularly participate in Catholic religious education in Kindergarten and First Grade.

**CONFIRMATION:** In order to receive the sacrament of Confirmation, young people must have regularly participated in Catholic religious education from First Eucharist until they are a Junior in High School. Classes are held the last Sunday of each month.

**RCIA:** Adult religious education classes – every Wednesday at 7 p.m. from September through Pentecost.

**SUNDAY SCHOOL/CCD:** Children/youth religious education classes every Sunday after Mass, September through May.

## RESPECT LIFE

"Although we may feel unsure how best to comfort those who mourn, we must stand with them in their time of suffering. Miscarriage touches the lives of many people, yet all too often this tragedy remains unaddressed. This lack of response not only often leads to unresolved grief, but also fails to clearly manifest our belief that each person, from conception onward, is precious and unique."
