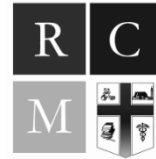

“...because I came down from heaven not to do my own will but the will of the one who sent me....” *JOHN 6:38*

- PRAY FOR THE UNBORN: The Rosary is said every 2nd Sunday before Mass. Please join us in the Sanctuary.
- SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM: Call the parish office to schedule a baptism class as well as a date for the baptism.
- RECONCILIATION is celebrated before Mass, and by appointment.
- SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE: The Archdiocese requires a four-month preparation period before marriage. A couple **must** inform the Parish Office before a date is set.
- SACRAMENT OF FIRST EUCHARIST: In order to receive the sacrament of First Eucharist in Second Grade, children must regularly participate in Catholic religious education in Kindergarten and First Grade.
- CONFIRMATION: In order to receive the sacrament of Confirmation, young people must have regularly participated in Catholic religious education from First Eucharist until they are a Junior in High School. Classes are held the last Sunday of each month.
- RCIA: Adult religious education classes – every Wednesday at 7 p.m. from September through Pentecost.
- SUNDAY SCHOOL/CCD: Children/youth religious education classes every Sunday after Mass, September through May.

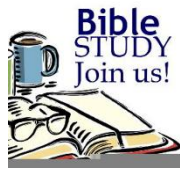
SANCTUARY CANDLE REMEMBRANCE

The Knights of Peter Claver was founded on November 7, 1909 in Mobile, Alabama providing a fraternal organization for African- Americans. Named after a 17th century priest who ministered to enslaved people, the Order was established by four priests of the Saint Joseph's Society of the Sacred Heart of Baltimore, Maryland and three laymen of the Diocese of Mobile. Goals include support of the parish, social justice and community advancement.
