BLACK CATHOLIC HISTORY MONTH ACTIVITES

Archdiocese of Mobile

Next Sunday, pilgrims from the Diocese of Jackson, MS and the Mobile area will journey to Montgomery for continued Black Catholic History Month celebrations, led by **Fr. Victor Ingalls, Director for Multicultural Ministry in the Archdiocese of Mobile**. Festivities in Montgomery will be held at the historic St. Jude Catholic Church beginning at 3:00 p.m., with the theme "On the Road to Sainthood" highlighting Servant of God, Sr. Thea Bowman, FSPA. Renowned keynote speaker **Fr. Tony Ricard** from the Archdiocese of New Orleans and several local choirs will participate. Earlier in the day, pilgrims will tour the Legacy Museum and other EJI sites starting at 11:00 a.m. Those interested in joining are encouraged to meet at the entrance to the Legacy Museum just before 11 a.m.

NOVEMBER, THE MONTH OF ALL SOULS

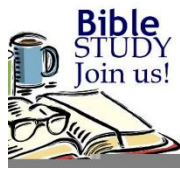
